Washington D.C. – The Household & Commercial Products Association (HCPA) released the following statement today, attributed to Steve Caldeira, President & CEO of HCPA, after President Trump and Chinese Vice Premier Liu He signed a trade agreement in a step to deescalate the ongoing trade war between the two countries, and includes a commitment by China to purchase \$200 billion in U.S. goods.
